An evidence-based look at COVID-19 as we understand the disease today and the best practices we can all take to keep others and ourselves safe.

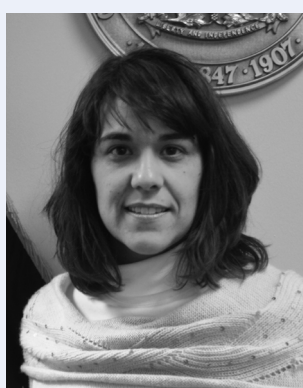
