FirstVet will provide telehealth services to Microchip ID Systems customers that register their companion animals to the BuddyIDTM registry and sign up with FirstVet.

FirstVet will provide a 5-step healthy pet check up to all pet parents registered in the BuddyID[™] database that have signed up with FirstVet. The checkup will be a 15-minute consultation with a licensed veterinarian designed to cover 5 key areas. They include oral health, skin and coat, ear and rear, food, movement, and mobility recommendations. The virtual telehealth evaluation will help pet parents understand the importance of regular veterinary visits as well as prepare new pet parents on what to look out for when it comes to caring for their pets.

At the same time, Microchip ID is launching a revolutionary new product that promises to make their BuddyIDTM registry even more responsive and user-friendly than ever before. A unique QR code on each BuddyBadgeTM allows lost pets to be immediately identified by anyone with a smartphone. This ensures that animals can be identified and returned to their owners quickly and reliably even when no microchip reader is available. The QR code on the tag is permanently linked to the BuddyIDTM microchip registration. The registration covers the lifetime of the pet and provides double protection in case they're ever separated from their owners.

Additionally, the BuddyIDTM database enables pet owners to designate trusted locations–such as a neighbor's home or a veterinarian's office–as a SafePlaceTM so that the pet can be easily brought to the closest one if the pet parent is unreachable. A Free SearchALERTTM can be launched as soon as a pet goes missing, which will automatically flag the pet's microchip in the BuddyIDTM database and in the national lookup tool.
